Faculty Development Programme

Work Life Integration

December 15-16, 2016

A two-day Faculty Development Programme in Human Resource was conducted by the Centre for Organisational Research Learning and Development of Jansons School of Business on December 15-16, 2016.

The theme was 'Work Life Integration: Challenges and Best Practices'.

The objectives of the FDP were:

- To create a space where participants can discuss and widen their knowledge about work life integration.
- To provide a wide range of work life integration strategies for participants' own change.
