Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is the JSB MBA Programme?

The MBA (Master of Business Administration) Programme is a 2-year full-time, fully residential programme, approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi, and nationally accredited by National Board of Accreditation, New Delhi. The Programme is also Internationally Accredited by ACBSP (The Accreditation Council for Business Schools and Programs), USA.

2. What is the admission process for the JSB-MBA Programme?

For admission, JSB accepts the previous year and current year scores in CAT, XAT, MAT, CMAT, GMAT and ATMA. In the case of TANCET, only current year Scores are accepted. The candidates short-listed, will be called for Group Discussion / Personal Interview at the JSB Campus e-mail/phone. **Candidates coming through TANCET Counselling will not have GD / PI.**

3. Is it a fully Residential Programme?

Yes, the JSB-MBA is a 2-year full-time, fully residential programme. All students should mandatorily reside in campus to facilitate participative learning and to make use of the curriculum supportive facilities like library and system-based information modules. The scope of participative learning is to impart group interactions, to develop interpersonal skills and to build a network of relationships among students, besides sharpening their focus on academic and professional excellence. In addition, all curriculum-related activities (like reading materials, tests, assignments, grading) are done through a completely online and digital Learning Management System (LMS) (<https://jsb.linkstreet.in/portal/login/>)

4. How can I obtain the application form of JSB?

The information brochure and application form can be obtained from the JSB office, either in person or through post. Application form can also be downloaded from <https://www.jsb.ac.in/mba-course-admissions>

Online registration can also be done with an option to pay by Credit Card/Debit Card/Net Banking/Demand Draft at <https://www.jsb.ac.in/mba-course-admissions>

A payment of Rs.750/- can be made through Credit Card / Debit Card / Net Banking / Demand Draft. Fees can also be paid online.

5. Is it necessary to have work experience to apply for the programme?

No, work experience is not mandatory for applying to this programme. But students with work experience are preferred.

6. What about Placements?

The Placement Programme at JSB is managed by the Centre for Corporate Relations. JSB has been achieving 100% placements for all those students who had shown interest and opted for placement programme, consistently.

1. Food charges may come to approximately Rs. 4,500 to 5,000 per month, payable monthly.
2. Examination Fees will depend on the number of electives / audit courses.
3. The dates for payment of fees will be informed on confirmation of admission

8. When do I need to submit the original documents to support the data I have filled in the form?

The original documents are required during the interview process. Subsequently document verification also takes place when the Programme begins. Every achievement and extra-curricular activity mentioned should be supported with documentary evidence.

9. What are all the Specialisations offered by the JSB-MBA Programme?

Marketing, Finance, Human Resources, Operations and Systems are the specialisations offered.

10. What is the curriculum structure followed?

JSB follows Semester system and has four semesters in total. More details on the curriculum structure can be found here:

It is not compulsory to have a laptop. However, bringing your own laptop will make it easy. Since the courses are linked to the online Learning Management System platform, it is advisable to use a digital device.

12. What is the total intake of the MBA programme?

The intake of the JSB-MBA Programme is 120 students.

13. What is the geographical mix of the students at JSB?

JSB has a good mix of students from across India. However, a majority of the students are from Southern States of India.

14. What is done for Co-curricular activities and/or Personality Development at JSB?

Personality Development is an integral part of the JSB-MBA curriculum. There is a set of dedicated sessions aimed at developing communication and contemporary management practices, like

- **Business Communication**
- **Team work**
- **Public Speaking**
- **Group Discussions**
- **Presentation**

The Career Commencement School at JSB creates an enabling ambience for students to enhance their personal effectiveness. The aim is to support and facilitate aspiring students for a gainful initial career in the world of business through periodical sessions on communication and aptitude tests. The JSB-MBA Programme also has various clubs/committees/Trading Room that complement classroom efforts. They provide a platform for all students to work on their personality in real time.

At JSB, every student is assigned a Faculty-Mentor to track the progress of the student, who intervenes as and when necessary. At JSB, we organise Meet the CXO, Executive Interaction Programmes (EIPs) and Alumni Interaction Programmes (AIPs) where the students will have intensive interaction with top-level and mid-level executives on contemporary organisational managerial practices and challenges.

15. Does JSB arrange for any educational loans?

No. However, JSB will support the candidates by providing necessary documents.

16. How are the hostel facilities at JSB?

A twin-sharing separate, spacious and convenient hostels are available for both male and female students with modern facilities like attached bathrooms, matted cots, work tables, closets, phone, Wi-Fi connectivity and separate Gyms. The hostels are modern, fully furnished with laundry and housekeeping facilities.

17. How is the mess facility at JSB?

At JSB, we have a specially designed fully air-conditioned Food Court. This is run by the students' Mess Committee. The Committee ensures food is of good quality with a mix of both North Indian and South Indian dishes (both Veg and Non-veg). It is a very transparent system.

18. What are the other facilities available at JSB campus?

JSB's Wi-Fi enabled campus has excellent facilities like fully air-conditioned audio-video enabled Gallery-type Classrooms, Computer Centre, Library and Information Centre, Syndicate Rooms and Auditorium. JSB's well-stocked library contains over 17900 books and subscribes to 88 periodicals and 11 leading dailies. The information centre has a unique and updated resource collection - EBSCO Data base that contains about 1000 online international journals relating to all fields of management, in addition to CAPITALINE, the financial database. It has a documentation centre where photocopying and printing services are professionally undertaken. There is a choice of sports-related facilities: Basketball, Table tennis, Badminton and Volleyball, besides a modern fitness and recreation infrastructure.

19. Is there any age limit to pursue the JSB-MBA Programme?

There is no age limit to apply for the JSB-MBA Programme.

20. Does JSB have any separate quota for NRI candidates?

No, JSB does not have any separate quota for NRI candidates.
